

Interpreting Symbols

Symbols are the foundation of clairvoyance. Whether it be through a reading, meditation or even dream work, we search for and attempt to interpret the symbols we see in order to find answers, guidance and clarity.

Although much has been written on the topic of symbols and in particular their meanings, the most effective interpretations are the ones that are unique to the reader. For example, a rose may mean love to one person and the presence of an ancestor to another.

This is not to say that we should dismiss suggested generic meanings (see p164-183). There are some interpretations that have been passed on from one generation to another and hold the same or similar meanings from culture to culture. The best way to interpret symbols is to combine ancient wisdom, intuition, logic and awareness.
